This petition has been moved by Ved @ Bedu under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.110 dated 5.4.2014 registered under Sections 302, 394, 397 IPC and 25/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Sadar District Sonapat.

It was submitted on the last date by counsel for the applicant-petitioner that co-accused had got bail which fact the State Counsel had denied. Also it was submitted that the petitioner had been convicted in three other cases.

Counsel for the petitioner has now placed on record copy of the order dated 4.7.2015 granting bail to co-accused Lokesh.

The police official from Sadar Sonapat who is present in Court submits that accused Anoop was also granted bail on 20.7.2015. A list submitted by the State Counsel shows that the petitioner is facing trial in

three cases including the present one for the offences under Sections 392, 394 and 397 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act. In three cases of theft, he was convicted and sentenced to the period already spent by him in custody while in two other cases of theft, he was acquitted.

At this stage, counsel for the applicant- petitioner wishes to withdraw the petition.
