SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The instant petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No. No.280 dated 25.11.2014, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Division Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar.

The submissions made by Mr.Abhinav Gupta, Advocate representing the petitioner and Mrs. Simsi Dhir Malhotra, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab have been heard.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that she is an illiterate lady and has been falsely implicated in the present case. She has

two daughters and her son is also in custody. She is in custody since 24.2.2015 and nothing is to be recovered from her. The investigations are complete and charge sheet has already been filed by the prosecution.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposed the prayer of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that the trial is likely to take some time, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is released on bail subject to her furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/ Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar.
