Mr.Gazi Mohammad, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of
the State of Punjab.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the present case is a case of version and cross-version and in the occurrence, two persons from the side of the accused including the petitioner sustained injuries. The injury constituting offence under Section 307 IPC has been attributed to non-applicant who has not been arrested till date. With regard to occurrence dated 06.07.2014, FIR was got registered in October 2014. The injured-victim, who allegedly sustained injury constituting offence under Section 307 IPC, was discharged from the hospital on 19.07.2014. The petitioner has been remanded to judicial custody, therefore, no longer required for the purpose of investigation.

Counsel for the State has not disputed factual assertions but

opposed the prayer.

The petitioner was arrested in the case on 28.11.2014. The injured in the FIR sustained one injury and that has been attributed to non-applicant. The petitioner was statedly armed with gandasa but he did not use his weapon for causing injuries. The presentation of challan and thereafter conclusion of trial is likely to take its own time.

Without meaning to express any opinion on merits of the controversy, bail to the petitioner subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court. However, he shall remain bound by the following conditions:-

- (i) he shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and
- (ii) he shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.
