Petitioner along with other co-accused had allegedly assaulted complainant Satnam Singh. Petitioner was armed with a 'dang' whereas his co-accused was armed with a 'dagar'. Petitioner has been attributed a simple injury on non-vital part i.e. right shoulder of the injured.

Pursuant to the interim orders passed, the petitioner has already joined investigation.

Without intending this order to be read as a precedent for the co-accused who is attributed a grievous injury with a sharp edged weapon, the petitioner can be granted the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Petitioner will join investigation as and when required;

- (2) Petitioner will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner; and
- (3) Petitioner will not commit any similar offence of which he is accused of during pendency of the trial.
