By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 133dated 26.07.02012, registered under Section 25 of Arms Act, at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

The learned counsel contends that petitioner was granted the concession of regular bail in this case and he was regularly attending the court proceedings. He could not appear on 29.09.2014,

as he was suffering from gastric and giddiness. The absence of the petitioner on the relevant date was stated to be bona fide and not intentional.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

Heard.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court, within a week from today and furnish fresh bail bonds/surety bonds. In the event of his doing so, he shall be admitted to bail by the releasing Court during the pendency of trial, to its satisfaction.
