Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing the P.O. order dated 20.09.2011 (Annexure P-3) passed by Sh. R.S. Bajwa, PCS JMIC, Nakodar in FIR No. 306, dated 29.11.2008(Annexure P-1), for offence under Sections 323, 324, 341 and 34 IPC (later on 326 IPC was added), registered at Police Station, Shahkot, District-Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the parties has jointly stated that in fact the matter has been compromised between the parties and copy of compromise has been placed on record in other petition i.e. CRM-M-No. 16042 of 2013.

Considering the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties and other accused has already been acquitted, petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial

Court on or before 17.07.2015 and trial Court shall admit the petitioner on bail, subject to his furnishing fresh bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
