Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.116 dated 05.03.2014, under Sections 323, 354-A, 406, 498-A, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short) (Section 377 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Palam Vihar, Gurgaon, Haryana.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 21.04.2014:-

“The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.116 dated 5.3.2014 registered under Sections 323, 354-A, 406, 498-A, 506 I.P.C. and section 377 I.P.C. (added later) at Police Station, Palam Vihar, Gurgaon.

Notice of motion, returnable for 12.5.2014.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be

released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Vijender Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 21.04.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
