ANITA CHAUDHRY J.

Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.106 dated 12.08.2011 registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 341, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur.

Heard.

Petitioner was granted anticipatory bail in the present FIR on 06.09.2012. The petitioner absented from the Court on 18.04.2015. His plea is that he met with an accident and could not attend the Court hearing. I find that no application was given in the Court for exemption. The case was taken up before lunch and even after lunch and the order was passed cancelling bail, in the presence of his counsel.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that information was passed on to the counsel representing the petitioner and he had prepared an application and had taken it to the Court but by then the order had been passed.

The state counsel informs that the case was fixed for prosecution evidence. The complainant side states that even the son of the petitioner had

not appeared.

The case is now posted for 14.05.2015. The petitioner would surrender before the trial Court on that day and file an application seeking regular bail. The trial Court would decide the same within two days.

The petition stands disposed of.
