The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking a direction against the private respondents not to harass or interfere in the peaceful married life of the petitioners. They are also seeking police protection as the petitioners apprehend danger to their life and personal liberty.

It is stated that the petitioners are major and have married against the wishes of their parents. Photographs in support of marriage are attached as Annexure P-3. The date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 22.02.1991, whereas petitioner No.2 is shown to be born in the year 1981 as per Annexure P-2.

In order to seek protection of their life and personal liberty, petitioner No.1 has submitted a Representation (Annexure P-4), dated 30.12.2014 before respondent No.2 i.e. the Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana, Punjab.

Without going into the controversy and the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. the Commissioner of Police, District

Ludhiana, Punjab, to look into the matter and issue appropriate direction within one month and ensure that no harm is caused to the life and personal liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents.

With the aforesaid observation, the present petition is disposed of.
