Reply by way of affidavit of Vivek S. Soni (IPS), Assistant Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Adampur Jalandhar has been filed in the Court today by learned State counsel on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and the same is taken on record.

It has been stated in the reply that a complaint was given by Amandeep Kaur wife of Manjinder Kumar. During enquiry into the allegations it was found that there was a prima facie case against the petitioners and FIR No.98 dated 30.07.2014 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC was registered at police Station Bhogpur, Jalandhar.

Petitioners No.1 and 2 were arrested, however, petitioner No.3 could not be arrested and proclamation proceedings were initiated against him and after completion of investigation, final report under Section 173 Cr. P. C was prepared and filed in the Court. Charges against the petitioners had also been framed.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhjit Singh

submits that there is no other case pending against the petitioners.

In the aforesaid premises, there is no merit in the petition.
