The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C raising a grievance that the petitioner is being harassed by respondents no.4 to 6, who are police officials so as to enter into a compromise with private respondent no.7 namely Gagandeep Bhardwaj and to withdraw a complaint that had been filed by the present petitioner under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act against the afore-noticed Gagandeep Bhardwaj and in which the competent court has even issued the summoning order.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same at the very initial stage in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent no.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana in relation to his grievance and apprehension and who in turn would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and which are warranted strictly in accordance with law.
