Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for directing respondent nos.2 and 3 to take action on the application of the petitioner.

Present petition apparently appears to be frivolous. In Annexure P/1, which is MLR, there is not only a cutting with regard to the name of the person who has been examined, but also the father's name. Initially, the medical report appears to be of one Jarnail Singh son of Amar Singh, thereafter, after scoring out the name of Jarnail Singh, Amarjeet Kaur wife of Joginder has been added. Furthermore, the cuttings are also regarding the age and sex. All the columns appear to have been tampered with.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn. This Court refrains from imposing the cost.
