This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.41 dated 18.02.2015 under Sections 307, 353, 186, 148, 149 IPC, Section 25 of Arms Act and Section 16 of Unlawful Activity Act, 1967 registered at Police Station City Faridkot.

The miscreants who came on two vehicles were stopped by the police party on 18.02.2015 and they fired on the police party and there was also exchange of fire for self defence. Two of those persons, namely, Ranjit Singh and Gurcharan Singh were apprehended at the spot. They disclosed the names of two other

persons, namely, Gurpreet Singh and Amitoj Singh. On the same day, the petitioner was also named by Ranjit Singh.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Paramjeet Singh submits that as per prosecution the petitioner was not amongst the six persons who fired at the police party but his name appeared because arms were supplied to them by the petitioner. No recovery was, however, made from him. Petitioner is in custody from 04.03.2015.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the fact that the trial will take time in conclusion, the instant petition is allowed and petitioner-Jaswinder Singh @ Rocky be admitted to bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
