Petitioner seeks the benefit of regular bail in case FIR No.100 dated 09.07.2013, under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 1.5 kgs. intoxicating powder was effected from the petitioner. As per FSL report, the contraband was found containing Dextropropoxyphene hydrochloride.

In the light of such huge recovery allegedly having been effected from the petitioner, this Court does not find any infirmity in the order dated 21.05.2014 passed by the learned Special Court, Rupnagar declining the prayer for regular bail.

Petition dismissed.
