Reply by way of affidavit of Mandeep Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (SD), Shahkot, District Jalandhar Rural has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 and states that the petitioner is not being called or pressurized by the police and the fact that the petitioner is being harassed by the police, is misconceived.

In view of the reply filed by the State, no order is required to be passed in the petition and the same is disposed of.
