Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Complaint Case No.31 dated 24.2.2012 titled as “Parvinder Singh Vs. Vijay Kumar and another” under Sections 323/452/34 and Section 3(1x)(x) of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 27.4.2015 of this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and the trial Court has admitted him on bail on his furnishing of bail bonds/surety bonds, to its satisfaction.
