Barjinder Pal Singh, Chief Judicial Magistrate, SBS, Nagar and Criminal Complaint Case No.387/14 dated 07.04.2014, titled 'Gurinder Pal Singh vs. Karanjeet Singh and others', pending in same

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Court and further for issuance of direction to decide both the cases at one go in order to avoid different verdicts and inconvenience to the parties to the lis.

In pursuance of notice of motion, Mr. Jagat Pal Singh, Advocate has filed power of attorney of Mr. Sarju Puri, Advocate, on behalf of respondents no.5 and 10 in Court today which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel has filed reply on behalf of respondents no.1 and 2 in Court today which is taken on record.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Offences levelled in the complaint are under Sections 307, 308, 323, 325, 326, 394, 395, 396, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code and the Court comes to conclusion that the accused are to be summoned under the aforesaid sections out of which some are exclusively triable by the Court of Session, therefore, both the cases cannot be tried together by one Court.
