The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.366 dated 26.09.2014, under Sections 302, 202, 34 of IPC registered with Police Station Gannaur, District Sonapat.

The case of the prosecution is based on the circumstantial evidence in the shape of a disclosure statement of the main accused-Ravinder, who stated to have stabbed the deceased-Surjeet @ Bhola and got the weapon of the offence i.e. Knife recovered, hidden from his house. The other evidence is of last seen by the complainant-father.

As per the allegations surfaced in the investigation, the petitioner-Ram Mehar @ Sanjay Kumar is stated to have got hold of the deceased while the main accused-Ravinder inflicted the fatal stabbed injuries with knife.

It is not in dispute that the charges were framed on 14.01.2015 and till now, no prosecution evidence has been examined. The petitioner/accused-Ram Mehar @ Sanjay Kumar is in custody since 26.09.2014.

Without adverting to the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the fact that the trial would take considerable time to conclude, it is deemed appropriate to release the petitioner/accused-Ram Mehar @ Sanjay Kumar on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Sonapat.
