This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in a case registered against them vide FIR No.137 dated 04.10.2014 under Sections 323/324 and 34 IPC, offence under Section 326 added later on at Police Station Nangal District Rupnagar.

FIR was registered on the statement of complainant-Vijay Kumar. He stated that on January 16, 2013 at about 9.00 p.m., he alongwith his relatives had gone to Metro Dhaba situated in the main market. At that time, there was a quarrel with the accused. Both the petitioners were having sharp-edged weapons. Petitioner No.2 caused the injury on the hands of brother of the complainant with a *cutter*. According to learned State counsel, injured had to be operated upon in PGI in department of plastic surgery for repair of tendon of right hand. He is now having residual stiffness in the hand and flexion loss.

In view of serious nature of allegations, I am of the

considered view that petitioners are not entitled to discretionary relief of pre-arrest bail. Dismissed.
