The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.8 dated 11.01.2013, under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act and Sections 392/395/457/458/380/411 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.8, Jalandhar.

Having argued the matter at some length, counsel prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Counsel would however raise a submission that the petitioner would duly surrender before the trial Court on the date already fixed i.e. 07.05.2015 and would pray that if an application seeking benefit of regular bail is filed, directions be issued for such application to be decided on the same very day.

As per prayer made by counsel, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, observed that in case, the petitioner duly

surrenders before the trial Court on 07.05.2015 and files an application seeking regular bail, the trial Court shall make every endeavor to expedite the hearing of the same.
