Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking a direction to the official respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, fairly states that before approaching this Court, petitioner did not move any appropriate representation to respondent No.2, i.e. Director General of Police, Punjab, for taking appropriate action on the report of Special Investigating Team. He further submits that given an opportunity, petitioner shall approach respondent No.2 by moving an appropriate representation within a period of one week from today and respondent No.2 may be directed to consider and decide the same, within a reasonable time.
