Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.493 dated 28.12.2014 under Section 323, 506 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 307 IPC (added lateron on 27.3.2015) registered at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak.

This Court vide order dated 27.4.2015, granted interim bail to the petitioner with a direction to join investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ramesh

Kumar, submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 27.4.2015, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required in this case.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 27.4.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
