By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.110, dated 24.09.2014, registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC, at Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that during the pendency of the present petition, the parties have entered into compromise and in view of the compromise, a petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act as well as quashing petition bearing No. CRM-M-22220 of 2015 has also been filed before this

Court. In pursuance of the order dated 26.05.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, admits the factum of compromise and states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 26.05.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
