The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.75 dated 12.05.20110 under Sections 498-A/406 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar on the basis of compromise.

The above said case was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Madhu Rachna alleging that the petitioners maltreated her after her marriage.

The matrimonial dispute having been amicably resolved parties were directed to appear before the Area Magistrate to get their statements recorded.

The complainant has received lump sum alimony and parted company under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act, from the petitioner No.1, Balwinder Kumar, her husband.

Report has been received from Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar that the matter has been compromised voluntarily. The complainant does not have any objection to the quashing of the aforesaid FIR.

Following the judgment of Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh vs. State of Punjab and others 2007(3) RCR(Crl.)1052**, I do not find any reason not to allow the present petition. This petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR along with all criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed, on the basis of compromise.
