Report dated 11.08.2015 sent by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Talwandi Sabo has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Baljit Singh and Naib Singh as well as of complainants Baltej Singh @ Kaka Singh and Narpinder Singh @ Gaggu it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.185 dated 04.08.2014 under Sections 365, 368, 34 IPC, Police Station, Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda and all other consequential

proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
