Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking a two fold relief. In the first instance petitioner seeks directions to the official respondents to take a decision upon a representation dated 5.3.2015 at Annexure P-13 which has been addressed to the S.S.P., District Tarn Taran, respondent no.4. The second relief is for seeking directions to the official respondents as regards protection of life and liberty of the petitioner on the basis of voicing an apprehension of threat to the same at the hands of private respondents no.6 to 11.

In so far as the the first prayer is concerned, counsel for the petitioner makes a submission that he is not pressing such relief and prays for liberty to avail of any other alternate and efficacious remedy that may be available as regards such grievance.

Counsel confines the scope of the present petition only as regards protection of life and liberty of the petitioner.

Without even going into the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without making any observations on merits, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach respondent no.4 i.e. S.S.P., District

Tarn Taran limited and confined only as regards the threat perception to his life and liberty at the hands of private respondents and in the eventuality of his doing so, respondent no.4 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as deemed necessary and warranted strictly in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
