The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 66 dated 29.07.2014 registered at Police Station City Mansa, District Mansa under Section 22/61/85 of NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is in custody for over a year and the trial is not proceeding and only two witnesses have been examined till the last date of hearing.

Report of the trial Court had been called for which shows that the trial is going at a slow pace.

Learned State counsel submits that 3 witnesses have been examined out of 7 witnesses.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
