Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for conducting investigation in case FIR No. 64, dated 29.05.2014, under Sections 465, 471, 468, 420, 201/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar by an independent agency other than the Punjab Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations are against respondent no.3 – Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, earlier he was Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Jalandhar (Rural). Learned counsel further contends that investigation should be entrusted to some other officer not below the rank of Inspector General of Police.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to Inspector General of Police, Punjab to look into the grievance of the petitioner and take action in accordance with law.
