JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.37 dated 21.03.2014, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 148, 149, IPC and (Section 307, IPC added later on), registered with Police Station Kurali, Tehsil Kharar, District Mohali (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the version of the complainant-Gurjinder Singh, on 20.03.2014 at around 7:30 PM, he along with his friend-Aman Singh was going towards a Stadium, when they were waylaid by the petitioner/accused-Sukhdeep Singh @ Barolu and his four other friends, armed with *Kirch* and *Dandas* respectively, inflicted injuries upon both the complainant and his friend-Aman Singh.

The injury attributed to the petitioner is of a *Kirch* blow on the abdomen of both the complainant and Aman Singh, which have been opined to be dangerous to life.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a version and cross-version of the occurrence. He further submits that it was the present complainant and his friend, who had entered in the house of petitioner and inflicted injuries to one Jaswinder Singh, cousin of the petitioner. He further submits that in both the versions, challan has been presented. He further submits that petitioner is in custody since 31.01.2015.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Harbhajan Singh, concedes regarding the custody period and filing of the challan in both version and cross-version.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the facts as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.

Disposed of.
