This is third application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.202 dated 13.12.2013 under Sections 21, 29 the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Maqsudan, Jalandhar City, District Jalandhar. The earlier bail applications were not decided on merits

The case of petitioner is exactly similar to that of Navpreet Singh @ Nav whose bail application was allowed vide order dated 30.03.2015 passed in CRM No.M-7951 of 2015.

No recovery of narcotic drugs or psychotropic substance was made from the petitioner. Allegation against the petitioner is that he was member of the gang engaged in supplying of narcotic drugs to the jail inmates.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting on the merits of the case and for the reasons recorded in the order dated 30.03.2015, allowing the bail plea of co-accused Navpreet Singh @ Nav in CRM No.M-7951 of 2015 and long period of custody, the petition is allowed and the petitioner-Baljit Singh be also admitted to bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
