With the consent of learned counsel for both the parties, the gold ornaments weighing 59.880 grams i.e. ear tops, bangles, gents kara and chain with locket, taken as case property in FIR No.16 dated 27.1.2010 registered at Police Station City Mansa are ordered to be given to Beena Goyal (paternal grand aunt of petitioner). These items be kept in bank locker till petitioner attain the age of majority or be sold and the amount so earned be deposited in the name of minor Krish Goyal son of Pardeep Goyal in the shape of fixed deposit till he attains the age of majority. On attaining the age of majority petitioner will be entitled to get possession of golden jewellery or to utilize the cash deposited in F.D.R, as the case may be, as per his wishes. He will not be required to seek any further orders from court for this purpose. The petitioner will supply the details of bank locker in which gold ornaments are kept or photo copy of the Fixed Deposit Receipt to the private respondents.

Consent order is passed and petition is disposed of accordingly.
