MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 187 dated 18.3.2015 registered under Sections 447, 511, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station City Jind, District Jind.

It has been contended that the petitioner is a bona fide purchaser and the allegations of fraudulent sale would not bind her. It has been further stated that all other co-accused who are similarly placed as the petitioner have been granted the benefit of pre-arrest bail.

Noticing the aforesaid facts, this Court has granted interim protection to the petitioner on 27.4.2015, subject to the condition that the petitioner joins the investigation. Pursuant to the aforesaid, petitioner has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer which fact is not controverted by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Vijender Singh.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case but noticing the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer, instant petition is accepted. Interim directions dated 27.4.2015 are hereby made absolute, however subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
