The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.447 dated 27.08.2014 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 325, 326, 307, 506 IPC at Police Station Camp Palwal, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 28.08.2014 and it is alleged that the petitioner had used iron rod in causing injuries to the victim Pankaj. He was accompanied by other unknown young boys with their weapons. As many as five injuries were found on the body of victim Pankaj. Out of five injuries, three were attributed by sharp edged weapon. No specific injury was attributed to the petitioner. It is further contended that the trial is in progress and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

On due consideration of the matter and noticing that the petitioner is in custody since 28.08.2014 and the fact that the trial would take time to conclude and sharp edged weapon injuries were not

attributed to the petitioner, the instant petition is accepted. It is directed that the petitioner be released on bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.PC subject to his furnishing of bail bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Palwal.

Nothing said herein shall be construed to be an expression on the merits of the case.
