Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for issuance of direction to official respondents No. 1 to 3 for conducting a fair and impartial inquiry in case FIR No. 70, dated 29.01.2015, for offence under Sections 363/366A/376D of IPC, Police Station, Nuh, District-Mewat, wherein, the son of the petitioner has been booked.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits a fair and impartial inquiry be conducted in the matter.

A bare perusal of the FIR shows that the complainant, namely, Taslima, daughter of Yousaf, caste Mew, resident of Akera, Police Station, Nuh, aged about 17 years, has made a specific allegation against Mohd. Yahya, son of Khurshid, resident of Akera, of committing rape upon the complainant.

Considering the fact that the FIR was lodged on 29.01.2015 and investigation is in the process, no further order is called for from this Court.

Accordingly, this present petition is dismissed.
