Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks quashing of FIR No.45 dated 14.02.2010 under Sections 204, 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B IPC and Section 13 (2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, registered at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot and the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. which had been filed on 16.01.2012.

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto, reply has been filed.
