RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (Oral)

Petitioner seeks bail pending trial in FIR No.10 dated 30.1.2015 registered under Sections 7, 8, 13, 49 and 88 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 at Police Station SVB Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner places reliance on an order dated 21.4.2015 (Annexure P-3) passed by this Court in CRM-M-11301-2015 (Devender Singh Siwach v. State of Haryana), whereby the main accused of the present FIR was granted bail by this Court. He further submits that since the case of the petitioner is on the better footing, he is entitled for bail pending trial.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sanjay Jumar, Police Station SVB Hisar, submits that petitioner is not entitled for bail pending trial. He prays for dismissal of the petition.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties at considerable length and keeping in view the order dated 21.4.2015 passed by this Court in Devender Singh Siwach's case (supra), whereby the main accused of the

present FIR was granted bail, the petitioner has been found entitled for bail pending trial.

In view of the above, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner is directed to be released on bail pending trial on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.

Disposed of, accordingly.
