JASPAL SINGH, J.

This order shall dispose of aforesaid two petitions i.e
CRM No. M-13420 of 2015, filed by Resham Singh and others and
CRM No. M-14082 of 2015, filed by Surjeet Singh and others.

2. CRM No. M-13420 of 2015 has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of DDR No.27, dated 22.06.2014, under Sections 323/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Amir Khas, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1), as well as all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 21.04.2015 (Annexure P-2) and affidavit dated 21.04.2015 (Annexure P-3).

3. CRM No. M-14082 of 2015, has also been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.194 dated 21.08.2014, under Sections 325, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Guruhar Sahai, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 21.04.2015 (Annexure P-2) and affidavit dated 21.04.2015 (Annexure P-3).

4. Report of learned trial Court has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have voluntarily entered into compromise and the same is genuine one. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which stood amicably settled.

5. In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

6. Consequently, both petitions are allowed and DDR No.27, dated 22.06.2014, under Sections 323/34 IPC, registered at Police

Station Amir Khas, District Ferozepur as also FIR No.194 dated 21.08.2014, under Sections 325, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Guruhar Sahai, District Ferozepur as well as all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner(s).
