Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 for initiating legal action against respondents No.5 to 8 who are extending threats to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

2. During the course of argument, learned counsel for the petitioner contended that though representation dated March 31, 2015 (Annexure P-2) was moved to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar but no action has been taken so far in respect of said representation by the concerned authorities.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to get the matter enquired into from an officer not below the rank of DSP and to look into various grouses of the petitioner ventilated through his representation dated March 31, 2015 (Annexure P-2) and in case some substance found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
