ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.711 dated 29.12.2014, registered under Section 135 of Electricity Act, Police Station Anti Power Theft, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 01.09.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioner has deposited 50% amount of fine imposed upon him and receipt in this regard has been handed over to Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Tara Singh Singh has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and has also deposited 50% amount of fine.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 11.05.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
