This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.55 dated 11.02.2008 registered at Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat for offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 read with Section 120-B IPC.

Heard.

Learned state counsel, on instructions from ASI Varinder Singh, submits that out of 13 prosecution witnesses, 11 PWs have already been examined. The petitioner has absented twice in this case and was declared proclaimed offender.

In view of the above and the fact that the case is near completion and there is every likelihood that the petitioner may abscond again if allowed bail, this petition is dismissed.

However, the trial Court is directed to expedite the disposal of the trial preferably within six months.
