This petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.174 dated 22.11.2014 registered at Police Station Division No.5, District Jalandhar for offences punishable under Sections 307, 341 and 506 read with Sections 148/149 IPC.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and has been released on bail as per order dated 28.04.2015.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation but he is not cooperating with the police to find out the whereabouts of the co-accused.

Keeping in view the above and the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation, but without commenting anything on merit of the case, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 28.04.2015 is made absolute, on the terms mentioned therein, till the presentation of challan.
