The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take appropriate action against respondents No. 4 to 8 for illegally detaining his wife and son and for threatening to eliminate the petitioner.

Petitioner appears to have already lodged a complaint with SHO Police Station Jalandhar Cantt. Annexure P-2, in this respect.

As per reply filed on behalf of respondents No. 4 to 8, it has been informed that a private complaint under Section 406 and 498-A IPC has already been filed by Preeti, wife of the petitioner against the petitioner and his mother and that proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C have also been initiated against the petitioner. The said proceedings have been initiated against the petitioner prior to filing of this petition. The petitioner has intentionally concealed the factum of his wife having filed the above said proceedings against him. Accordingly, the petition deserves to be rejected outrightly as an attempt has been made to play fraud with the Court and create a defence in the said proceedings.
