This petition has been moved by Lalinder Parshad under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.101 dated 20.7.2013 registered under Sections 302/120-B IPC and 25/27/54 of Arms Act at Police Station Shimlapuri, Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that Lalita Devi was the main accused with Lal Bahadur who has been granted bail. The petitioner has been falsely involved.

State Counsel submits that the case is fixed for 26.5.2015 before the trial Court for which date four police officials have been summoned. However, the main witnesses Sanjay Parshad, Raj Kumar and Nitish Kumar remained to be examined. Though the petitioner is in custody since 4.8.2013, it is felt that it is not a fit case for grant of bail because the main witnesses are yet to be examined and Nitish Kumar is stated to have seen the assailants. The petition is dismissed. However, it is ordered that the trial Court shall fix a short date after 26.5.2015 on which date the private witnesses mentioned above shall be summoned and the prosecution shall produce those witnesses for their statements.
