JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioner-Deepak Kumar in case FIR No.30 dated 14.02.2014 for offence punishable under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Phase-1 Mohali, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

As per the allegations, the father of the petitioner namely Om Parkash on the strength of a power of attorney executed by the grandfather of the petitioner qua his unsatisfied claims in lieu of land left in Pakistan, being a displaced person were sold to the complainant party. The sale deed was to be executed on the contingency of the claim petitions being decided

in favour of the claimants. Concededly the claim petitions were dismissed after the agreement.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner contends that the entire set of allegations, even assuming to be correct relates to his father and the petitioner has absolutely no role in the said transaction. He further submits that pursuant to the interim directions petitioner has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Dilbagh Singh concedes that after investigation challan has been presented.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the above said circumstances, interim bail/protection granted in favour of the petitioner vide order dated 15.05.2014 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands disposed off.
