Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 33, dated 27.02.2015, under Section 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Samana, District Patiala.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

Admittedly, the Punjab State Warehousing Corporation has entrusted 125431 bags weighing 43900.85 qtls. of paddy for the year 2012-13. The petitioner was supposed to give rice after milling the same. But instead of performing his duty, the petitioner is alleged to have misappropriated the said paddy bags which has resulted into loss of Rs.3,03,98,388/-. In this scam, it appears that petitioner and others may be involved. In such cases, custodial interrogation is necessary.

No ground for anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
