Jagdeep Singh petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.31 dated 15.4.2013 under Sections 406, 420 IPC registered at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala (Annexure P1) along with consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 12.3.2014 (Annexure P2).

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala was called for. Learned Magistrate has submitted the report. He has recorded the statements of the complainant as well as the accused and has reported that the parties have effected compromise and the same is genuine, without any pressure or coercion.

In this case, there was a dispute regarding Rs.8,50,000/- taken by the accused from the complainant to send him abroad.

Since it was a monetary dispute and the same has been amicably settled, therefore, FIR No.31 dated 15.4.2013 under Sections 406, 420 IPC registered at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala (Annexure P1) alongwith the consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
