MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.2 dated 31.01.2015, registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Women Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

The dispute has arisen on account of marital discord and noticing this, the Court had granted interim protection to the petitioner on 29.04.2015, pursuant to which the petitioner has joined the investigation, which fact has not been controverted by the learned counsel appearing for the respondent/State, on instructions from ASI Jasveer Singh. Besides, it has been categorically asserted by the counsel for the petitioner with some material to indicate in support thereof that dowry articles have been returned to the complainant.

Having regard to the aforesaid, the interim directions dated 29.04.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
