Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.54 dated 18.02.2015, under Sections 353, 186, 332, 506, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines Tehsil and District Amritsar on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2-complainant Jaswant Singh alleging that petitioner had attacked the complainant and Dr. N.S. Neki on account of death of the brother of the petitioner who was suffering from swine flue and was being treated by complainant.

Under the directions of this Court, statements of complainant and Dr. N.S. Neki have been recorded and it is reported that the matter has been compromised voluntarily.

In view of above said circumstances, I do not find any ground not to permit compounding the offences and quash the proceedings.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052,** the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
