This is a petition for quashing of FIR No.78 dated 28.04.2014, under Section 324 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station, Division No.1, Jalandhar, at the instant of respondent No.2, alleging that the petitioner has abused the complainant and assaulted with a sword hitting him on the left arm and stomach. Offence under Section 324, IPC, is triable by Magistrate.

The matter is stated to have been compromised.

The parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received

that the matter has been compromised amicably without any threat, coercion and undue influence.

In view of the assault case having been amicably compromised, following the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab & Ors. 2007 (3) RCR Criminal, 1052,** the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise, subject to a condition that the petitioner will deposit a sum of ₹ 10,000/- with Punjab State Legal Services Authority, Sector-22, Chandigarh, within a period of one month.
