Notice of motion.

On asking of the court, Mr. Yogesh Gupta, AAG, Punjab, who is present in the court accepts notice and submits that intimation by Registry informing of fixation of the petition has already been received and record of the case is available with him.

The FIR bearing No.35 dated 23.2.2015 for offence punishable under Section 452/307/324 IPC, was registered at Police Station Sadar, Patiala, on the complaint of Baljinder Kaur wife of Harjinder Singh. As per allegations in the FIR, occurrence took place on 22.2.2015 when Gagandeep Singh entered the house of the complainant and attacked her mother-in-law. The role attributed to the petitioner is that she has made call to Gagandeep Singh before the occurrence informing him that all the members of family of complainant have gone for their work. The petitioner was arrested on 18.3.2015 and is in judicial custody since then. She has not been attributed any injury in this case.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Patiala.
